

Terms and conditions of sale Marie Jeanne Swing

The employer is responsible for the material stored in the premises made available to the group, from its arrival until its departure (musical instruments, sound and lighting equipment, stage costumes, etc.).

The employer will provide the group with the installation necessary for the proper performance of the show (electrical installation in accordance with standards, dressing room...).

The present concert shall be suspended or cancelled by right and indemnity of any kind, in all cases recognised as force majeure: war, attack, revolution, prefectoral notice of bad weather, natural disaster, national mourning, general strike, riot, epidemic or any other case of force majeure requiring the closure of the concert halls.

In the case of an open-air show, the organiser must provide a covered stage or a fallback room.

Any other case of cancellation in the open air, rain and bad weather are not a case of force majeure but may, by their intensity, prevent the performance from taking place. In this case, all possibilities of moving the performance in time or to another location will be studied according to the availability of the rooms belonging to the employer.

In the event of a dispute relating to the application of the present contract, the parties agree to refer to the competent courts, but only after exhaustion of amicable means (conciliation, arbitration, etc.).

Deposit: 50€ with the order, 30% 60 days before the event, the balance on D-7.
